Student Sports Organising Committee Leadership at George Spencer Academy

Student sports leadership is strong at George Spencer Academy, with 50+ leaders qualifying in Year 10 every year. We want to put together a team of dedicated members to ensure that student voice is effective, and ideas are acted upon by the PE department.

School Sports Organising Committee:

Made up of:

- 5 X female Sports Captains
- 5 X male Sports Captains

Vice-Sports Captains

- 5 X female Vice-Sports Captains
- 5 X male Vice-Sports Captains

Student sports leaders are appointed for a 12-month term, and are selected through an application and interview process. The Sports Captains and Vice-Sports Captains need to have qualities that will enable them to fulfil the demands of their roles. A member of the School Sport Organising Committee will:

- Be able to use their initiative;
- Show commitment to the school and their leadership role;
- Be reliable and have good time management skills;
- Demonstrate good organisation skills (personal and the ability to work in teams);
- Be determined and persevere to achieve success;
- Show humility (the role represents the School, but at the same time it represents a service to the other students);
- Act with responsibility;
- Demonstrate leadership;

Appointment process

If you wish to be considered for a position on the School Sports Organising Committee then, you must submit a completed application form to Mrs Walker. Applicants who have submitted an application will be shortlisted and invited to interview. Appointments will be announced thereafter.

The School Sports Organising Committee

The School Sports Organising Committee shadow the School Sport Co-ordinator and play a vital role in the raising the profile of school sport. There are two Sports Captains in every year group, who are all members of the School Sports Organising Committee and represent the sporting views of the school. The School Sports Organising Committee are also responsible for organising regular inter-house competitions in a variety of sports and activities for all age groups, as well as making pupils aware of sporting opportunities in the local community.

They will be involved in fundraising ideas, helping to organise Sports Relief events, being a part of the National Schools Sports Week, be involved in Sky Sports projects, the extra-curricular timetable at GSA, their views on the PE curriculum and Sports Day.

The School Sports Organising Committee will meet once a half term to organise events and discuss new initiatives.

The Sports Captains

The appointed Sports Captains for each year group will play a role in the organisation and leadership of sport in the school. They will be given responsibilities such as organising teams, arranging Sports Leaders to support in clubs, promoting Sport at GSA. They will be integral in collecting the sporting views of their year group and feeding this back to the Committee/PE department.

The Vice-Sports Captains

The appointed Vice-Sports Captains for each year group will play an important role in assisting the Sports Captain in the organisation and leadership of sport in the school. There will be two Vice-Sports Captains in each year group, one female and one male.
