If you have tried to log in to Insight, you may have been given security warnings from your web browser. This is because we are awaiting the security certificate for the website to be verified by an external provider. We anticipate this will be complete in the next few days but wanted you to be able to access the scan and Insight before half term so any issues could be ironed out. Our ICT team can confirm that there is no risk in proceeding to the website as it is a George Spencer site, with appropriate levels of security in place.

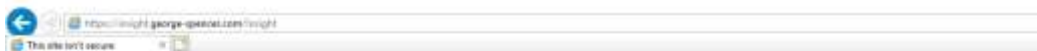

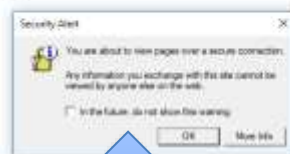
