- There is a small café and vending machines selling drinks and snacks.

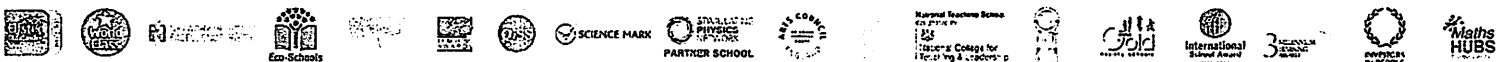
