Dress Code

The Sixth Form dress code is designed to encourage a more business like environment and to instill standards and responsibility. Sixth Form dress should be fit for the purpose of study.

To this end, from September 2017 the Sixth Form dress code for Year 12 and 13 is as follows.

Dress Code

- Plain black, navy, grey smart skirt/dress (just above the knee or longer) or trousers (no denim, jeans style or canvas)
- Formal shirt/blouse
- Formal shoes (no trainers, canvas or leisure shoes)

Optional

- Tie
- Smart jumper or cardigan
- Suit style jacket (black, navy, grey)
- Outdoor coats (no denim, leather or 'hoodie' style)

This sensible, smart code is for all students to follow. We expect students to use their common sense when selecting clothes to wear to Sixth Form. Students who do not conform will be sent home to change.

The Sixth Form Director or PSA will make the final decision about what is appropriate.
